

Vocational Ministry Apprenticeships at North Hills Church

This is more than an internship. We are not looking for free student labor, as a ministry apprentice at North Hills church, you will operate as a member of the NH staff, training alongside our team while stewarding a distinct ministry opportunity. It is my goal as Lead Pastor of our church to give you relevant experiences to compliment your education and develop leadership and shepherding skills. As part of our church staff team you will be continually challenged in your leadership, and the soft skills that compliment your ministry projects.

Pastoral and shepherding development is the heart of our ministry. You will be involved with pastors and ministry leaders "up close and personally" as they function within the church. At the end of the program, you'll possess the experience, insights, and skills necessary to successfully step into full-time vocational ministry, whether as a pastor, missionary or ministry director. Through our program we can bestow a job title upon your efforts that can propel your resume and additional references based on working alongside you that will launch your job search upon graduation.

Overview

Below you will find the basic layout of job descriptions for North Hills Church Apprentices. The Apprentices first and foremost report to the lead pastor and then to their respective ministry coach(es).

Apprentice Expectations

- Apprentices are men and women above the age of a High school graduate with significant ministry experience who desire to pursue vocational ministry and are seeking to be developed towards that end. Our apprentices are typically pursuing their bachelor or graduate degrees.
- Apprentices are expected to attend weekly Team meetings on wednesdays at 12:15pm for participation with our staff and leadership development.
- Each year there will be one Ministry Conference attended by the staff and apprentices that will have to be budgeted for by the apprentice and scheduled with any professors if applicable.
- Because apprentices work 15-20 hours a week and have a high level of ownership in their respective ministries they are considered to be a part of the North Hills staff team. Integration into staff culture is expected from the apprentice and the North Hills staff are expected to treat them as an integral part of the ministry.



Apprentice Ministry Description

The vast majority of the Apprentices' experience will be defined by the individual's ministry field (e.g. Teaching ministry, Special Needs ministry, women's ministry, men's ministry, etc.). Each Ministry description is written to include what you can expect to experience and learn as well as what you are responsible for in your respective position.

- The methodology of the apprenticeship is in an "observe, assist, debrief, and own" model as each apprentice works in close proximity with full-time staff. Apprentices will observe what full-time staff does (i.e. their personal ministry coach) while being handed ownership over some aspect(s) of the particular ministry they have been placed in.
- The hourly expectation of Apprentices is 15-20 hours a week (including training, and meetings)

Further Details

Where: North Hills Church of God

When: New apprentices start on a candidate by candidate basis.

Duration: typically 9-10 mo.

Time Commitment: 15 -20 hours/week

Cost: There is no direct cost for this program outside of what naturally occurs for your commute, clothing, meals etc.

Compensation: Hourly at a rate of \$15/hour or commensurate with experience.
